SUBJECT: History

Year: 9

Topic(s) to be covered

We will begin by studying the Second World War both the reasons for it and the key events that took place during it. After this unit we will study the Cold War and consider what life was like in Europe in its shadow. The final unit of year 9 will focus on the post war consensus: the origins of the NHS and the impact of migration into Britain.

Assessment Procedures

1. Skills assessments which will focus on key historical skills such as: source analysis, cause and consequence or interpretation of historical texts.
2. Regular exit tickets at the end of lessons to ensure that students are on track.

End of year test to focus on all topics studied: the First World War, the Second World War and post war Europe.

Homework guidance

Each week students will receive at least one homework for which they will be expected to spend a minimum of 30 minutes completing. These will be a combination of written, research, Teams, investigative homeworks.

Failure to complete homework will result in a 30 minute after school detention in which they will be expected to complete the homework.
