SUBJECT: MFL - French

Year: 10

Topic(s) to be covered

This term you will explore the following topics: Food and meals, clothes daily routine, family celebration and festivals, weather, town and country, directions, holiday problems, role-play practice for the speaking exam in Year 11.

You will also develop the following skills:

- Asking and responding to questions
- Understanding the present tense, past tense, future tense and conditional tenses
- Giving opinions and descriptions
- Using simple and complex connectives and prepositions
- Reading and listening for gist and detail and inference
- Speaking and writing spontaneously
- Translating a text into French
- Translating a text from French into English
- Describing a photo in French
- Understanding simple literary texts

Assessment Procedures

Assessment 1 – Pupils will complete a listening and reading exam paper. Students will do exam skills and practice questions before the assessment.

Assessment 2 – written assessment

Write a text between 90 - 150 words. More details will be given to students nearer the time.

Students will need to have a good secure understanding of the present, past and future tenses. This will also include a translation from English into French.

Students will complete practice questions in class in preparation for this assessment.

Homework guidance

Students will be asked to learn vocabulary, this may be on a website called Quizlet, students will also complete written tasks / reading activities. Students should be discouraged from using web-based translation websites e.g. Google Translate.

Enrichment opportunities

Students will use Kahoot / Quizlet Live as an engaging and interactive way of assessing vocabulary. Students also use Blooket as a way of reinforcing vocabulary.
