**SUBJECT: History**

**Year: 10**

**Topic(s) to be covered:**

Early Elizabethan England – we follow the Edexcel 1-9 syllabus. This unit allows students to study the changing ways in which society and culture changed during the Elizabethan period in England. Students will also focus on England's adventures overseas.

**Assessment Procedures:**

- Interim assessments
- Cumulative assessment based on Paper 2 knowledge & skills

**Homework guidance:**

Homework is set WEEKLY. Sometimes there may be more than one piece. There may be some occasions when staff will request students to complete work or investigate a particular element of their study. There will be a combination of written, research, investigative Homeworks. Failure to complete homework will result in a 30 minute after school detention.
