Assessment Procedures:

Assessment 1: Speaking assessment

Students will be required to answer questions on the current topic. Students will be given more guidance and class time to prepare. Students will be required to revise for homework.

There will also be regular vocabulary tests where pupils are required to learn vocabulary at home. The pass mark is 6 out of 10.

Homework guidance:

Students will receive weekly homework such as new vocabulary to learn and there will be regular vocabulary tests. Students will also be required to revise thoroughly for the assessments. They may be asked to repeat assessments if they have not worked to the best of their ability.
