




Why are we here?

• We want all of our students to achieve a **minimum** of a Grade 5 in English and maths

• A Grade 5 is a STRONG pass (a Grade 4 is a STANDARD pass)

Did you know research shows...



Grade 5 in English Language...

2019 Grade Boundaries

Grade 5 = 59%

- Paper 1 (64 marks) Minimum 38 marks
- Paper 2 (96 marks) Minimum 57 marks

So, how are we going to get the marks we need? Where are the 'easy' marks? What do you need to learn?





Paper 1 Section A (24 marks) <u>Questions 1 and 2</u> = 3 marks (copying words and quotes) <u>Question 3</u> = 6 marks (language and structure) = 2 paragraphs <u>Question 4</u> = 15 marks (evaluation) = 3 paragraphs

<u>Revision Checklist:</u> Learn language techniques, structural techniques, approach to Question 3 and Question 4.





Paper 1 Section B (40 marks)

- Choice of TWO questions
- You have to write a story (2 to 3 sides)

<u>Revision Checklist:</u> Create a story in advance (at home) or learn the story that you have just written in class; how to use different types of punctuation; how to use different sentence types.





Paper 2 Section A (56 marks)

• Read Text 1

<u>Questions 1 and 2</u> = 4 marks (copying words and quotes)

<u>Question 3</u> = 15 marks (language and structure) = 3 paragraphs

• Read Text 2

<u>Questions 4 and 5</u> = 2 marks (copying words and quotes)

<u>Question 6</u> = 15 marks (evaluation) = 3 paragraphs

• Both Texts

<u>Question 7a</u> = 6 marks (Compare = Point & Evidence only = 3 paragraphs) <u>Question 7b</u> = 14 marks (Compare writer's methods = 3 paragraphs)



<u>Revision Checklist:</u> Learn language techniques, structural techniques, approach to Questions 3, 6, 7a and 7b.



Paper 2 Section B (40 marks)

- Choice of TWO questions
- You have to write either a speech, letter, article, report or essay

<u>Revision Checklist:</u> Learn the features of a speech, letter, article, report or essay; how to use different types of punctuation; how to use different sentence types.


