**SUBJECT: History**

**Year: 8**

**Topic(s) to be covered:**

**Tudor England: Church, State & Society:**

In this scheme of work, students will learn about the impact of the different Tudor and Stuart monarchs. We will assess how their actions affected the state and society during their reigns. We will also gain an awareness of how these historical events have shaped and impacted on our country and world today.

**Assessment Procedures:**

- Interim assessments
- Cumulative assessment based on learning and skills acquired in Year 7 Summer term and Year 8 Autumn term

**Homework guidance:**

Each week students will receive at least one homework, for which they will be expected to spend a minimum of 30 minutes completing. These will be a combination of written, research, investigative homework's. Failure to complete homework will result in a 30 minute after school detention.

**How can you help?**

Site visits to places with links to the Tudors would enhance their understanding of the main topic of the Autumn Term, e.g. Kenilworth Castle, Hampton Court, the Globe Theatre. Any site visits or museum visits with links to British life and events from c. 1485-1603 in the Autumn term would be incredibly beneficial to the learning and the enjoyment of this course: e.g. Tudor World, Stratford Upon Avon.

You can help them by ensuring their homework is completed on time. Support them with their written work and encourage them to research and then reduce and summarise information rather than copying from the internet.

Encourage them to read out their work to you and explain it in their own words to ensure that they understand it. Get them to check through their work and correct errors with spellings and presentation.
