SUBJECT: MFL - German

Year: 10

Topic(s) to be covered

This term students will explore the following topics: **School, relationships and house and home, daily routine, food, technology, holidays, describing a photo (preparation for the speaking exam in Year 11).**

Students will also develop the following skills:

- Asking and responding to questions
- Understanding the present tense, past tense, future tense and conditional tenses
- Giving opinions and descriptions
- Using simple and complex connectives and prepositions
- Reading and listening for gist and detail and inference
- Speaking and writing spontaneously
- Translating a text into German
- Translating a text from German into English
- Describing a photo in German in preparation for the mock speaking exam next year.
- Understanding simple literary texts in German

Assessment Procedures -

Assessment 1 - Listening and Reading GCSE papers - students will do practice questions and exam skills before the assessment.

Assessment 2 - Written

Write a text between 90 -150 words. More details will be given to students nearer the time.

This will also include a translation from English into German.

Foundation = test of 40 words and then a text of 90 words and a translation.

Higher = text of 90 words, a text of 150 words and a translation.

Students will be given guidance on how to complete the different tasks.

Homework guidance

Students will be asked to learn vocabulary, this may be on a website called Quizlet, students will also complete written tasks / reading activities. *Students should be discouraged from using translation websites such as Google Translate when completing work.*

Written homework - pupils should use the learning mat with the tenses on for support - all students have been given this.

Enrichment opportunities

Students will use engaging and interactive web-based quiz activities such as Kahoot and Quizlet Live and Blooket to learn and assess vocabulary. Quizlet and Blooket are excellent for retrieval of vocabulary and phrases.
