SUBJECT: History

Year: 7

Topic(s) to be covered:

In this term students will begin with a brief introduction to the main skills of history learning!

We focus on the impact of the Norman invasion of 1066.

Students will then begin to look at 'Medieval Church, State & Society' - considering some of the key events, changes and individuals in British history between 1066 and 1485.

Assessment Procedures:

- Interim assessments
- Cumulative assessment going over learning and skills acquired in the Autumn Term

Homework guidance:

Each week students will receive at least one homework, for which they will be expected to spend a minimum of 30 minutes completing. These will be a combination of written, research, investigative Homeworks. Failure to complete homework will result in a 30 minute after school detention.

How can you help?

You can help them by ensuring their homework is completed on time. Supporting them with their written work and encouraging them to research and then reduce and summarise information rather than copying from the internet.

Encourage them to read out their work to you and explain it in their own words to ensure that they understand it. Get them to check through their work and correct errors with spellings and presentation.
