SUBJECT: Religious Studies GCSE

Year: 11

Topic(s) to be covered:

- Dialogue within and between religious and non-religious beliefs and attitudes.
- Beliefs, teachings and practices Islam.

We will further embed the skills of analysis and evaluation; understand the influence of religion on individuals, communities and societies; develop knowledge and understanding of religious beliefs, teachings and sources of wisdom and authority; and understand significant common and divergent views within religions and beliefs.

Assessment Procedures:

1. Exam questions and practise questions throughout the topic.
2. Cumulative assessments.

Homework guidance:

Each week students will receive homework for which they will be expected to spend a minimum of 30 minutes completing. These will be a combination of written, creative, and research homeworks.

Failure to complete homework will result in a 30 min after school detention.
