



What does it consist of?

The course is **made up of three components**: two that are internally assessed and one that's externally assessed.



What content will this course cover?

Component 1, Exploring the performing arts. Toachieve this aim students will:

- Explore performance styles, creative intentions and purpose.
- Investigate how practitioners create and influence what's performed.
- Discover performance roles, skills, techniques and processes.

Component 2 – Developing skills and techniques in the performing arts. To achieve this students will:

- Take part in workshops, classes andrehearsals.
- Gain physical, interpretive and rehearsal skills.
- Apply these skills in performance.
- Reflect on their progress and performanceand how they could improve.



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What content will this course cover?

Component 3 – performing to a brief (externally assessed). To achieve this aim students will:

- Use the brief and previous learnings to comeup with ideas
- Build on their skills in classes, workshops andrehearsals
- Review the process using an ideas and skillslog.
- Perform a piece to their chosen audience
- Reflect on their performance in an evaluation report.
