SUBJECT: History

Year: 9

Topic(s) to be covered:

The Twentieth Century

In this scheme of work, students will learn about two case studies from the Twentieth Century. The first case study is World War One – the causes, main events/controversies and consequences of this conflict will be investigated and evaluated. During this term we then move onto the impact of WW1 and its links to the causes and events of World War Two.

Assessment Procedures:

- Interim assessments
- Cumulative assessment based on learning and skills acquired in Summer term Year 8 and Autumn term Year 9

Homework guidance:

Each week students will receive at least one homework, for which they will be expected to spend a minimum of 30 minutes completing. These will be a combination of written, research, investigative Homeworks. Failure to complete homework will result in a 30 minute after school detention.

How can you help?

Site visits or museum visits with links to World War One in the Autumn term would be incredibly beneficial to the learning and the enjoyment of this course – e.g. Staffordshire Regimental Museum (nr Lichfield), National Memorial Arboretum, Imperial War Museums.

You can help them by ensuring their homework is completed on time. Supporting them with their written work and encouraging them to research and then reduce and summarise information rather than copying from the internet.

Encourage them to read out their work to you and explain it in their own words to ensure that they understand it. Get them to check through their work and correct errors with spellings and presentation.
