

Year 10 French: Unit 5 - Customs, festivals and celebrations



Topic(s) to be covered

This term students will explore the following topics:

- Customs and celebrations, question words and subject-verb inversion, c'est and il y a.
- Birthdays and other personal special days, direct object pronouns (me, te, le, la), present tense of common irregular verbs.
- Describing popular customs in the past, y and en, imperfect tense.
- Recent festivals, irregular plural nouns, revision of perfect tense with avoir and être.
- Past and future festivals, definite and indefinite articles, past and near future together.
- Planning a trip to a festival, relative clauses with que, qui and où, the future tense of être, aller, faire and avoir.

Assessment Procedures

Homework guidance

Students will receive a minimum of one homework per week for which they will be expected to spend a minimum of 30 minutes completing. The homework will usually be to learn key vocabulary or complete listening and reading tasks on www.languagenut.com. If there are upcoming assessments, revision homework may be set.

In cases where homework has not been completed, MFL teachers may grant a day extension. If the homework is still not completed following this extension, this will result in a 25 minute after school detention.
