

Mathematics GCSE Information

Key information about the mathematics GCSE:

- Statutory GCSE – everyone has to take it
- Exam board – Edexcel (information on the spec can be found using this link: <https://qualifications.pearson.com/en/qualifications/edexcel-gcses/mathematics-2015.html>)
- Terminal assessment (all tested by exams at the end of the course)
- 3 Papers sat in total – (1 non-calculator, 2 calculator papers)
- Content
 - builds on work done during KS3 (number, algebra, ratio and proportion, geometry, statistics, probability)
 - big emphasis on applying skills and problem solving

Equipment

- Pupils need all the following equipment every lesson:
 - Pen, pencil, ruler and **CALCULATOR**
- In exams pupils will also need a compass and protractor (we would advice having their own for lessons as well but it is not compulsory)
